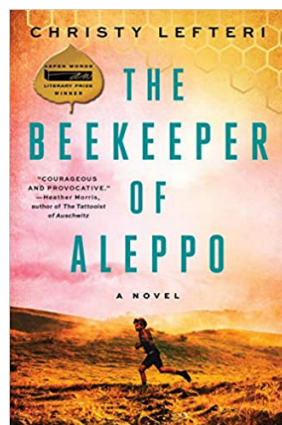
**In January, we Toured the Frida Kahlo-Diego Rivera Exhibit at NC Museum of Art**

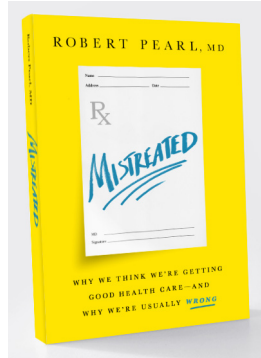
**On January 28th, Book Club met for their first meeting of 2020**
