

## Nominating and Leadership Development Committee Job Description

The Nominating and Leadership Development Committee shall strive to identify, attract, and develop the most competent physician leadership in The Society. (Source: NCMS Bylaws)

Position: Nominating and Leadership Development Committee - Regions 1, 2, 3, 4

Term: 2 years

### NLDC Responsibilities:

- a. To consult and understand the Mission and Strategic Plan of the NCMS.
- b. To identify and recruit candidates for office who are capable of providing leadership to the Society as it works to fulfill the mandates of its Mission.
- c. To participate fully in the work of the NLDC as directed by its Chair and the NCMS Board of Directors.

Procedure:...The Nominating and Leadership Development Committee shall make at least one nomination for each of the positions to be elected each year. During all its deliberations and when making its nominations, the committee shall consider the best interests of The Society and the medical profession. Members of the committee may consult other members and otherwise perform due diligence on those under consideration to ensure the best interests of The Society. (B-5.20213)

**\*The Committee will also interview candidates interested in serving as a NCMS appointee to a State board or commission.** (Ex: NC Medical Care Commission, NC Professionals Health Program, NC Commission for Public Health)

The NLDC typically meets three times a year (virtual meetings).
