

Participate in Dementia Nomenclature Initiative Pilot Study to Improve Communication about Cognitive Impairment

We are looking for **dementia specialists/neurologists** to help us create a clinical practice tool to improve the consistency and clarity of communication about dementia diagnosis.

To qualify, participants must:

- Screen and diagnose at least 25 adults with cognitive impairment per year
- Complete an intake survey to determine eligibility
- Be willing to complete a one-on-one interview by video call, lasting about 1 hour



Participants will receive \$1,000 compensation for their time and feedback.

This pilot study is sponsored by the Lewy Body Dementia Association, the Alzheimer's Association, and other partners. The goal of the study is to refine a Communications Framework for improving communication between clinicians, patients, and families regarding cognitive impairment.

The interview will focus on the clarity of the Communications Framework, potential benefits and challenges of implementing it in clinical encounters, and suggestions for revision.
